The Support Services Committee met on April 29 and discussed the following:

- It was reported that Phase Five of the Inglewood Elementary School Renovations and Additions Project would be completed by May 10 and classrooms would once again be shifted to the completed wing. The project is still about 6 weeks ahead of schedule. Phase 6 work began on Monday, May 13.
- The committee was informed of **Potential Energy Projects** recommended by the administration for North Penn High School and the Educational Services Center. Both Buildings are in need of electrical lighting and HVAC upgrades. Lighting at both locations is either no longer being made or will soon be out of production. The Administration recommended that they look into the potential costs of remediating the issues the committee agreed and directed Administration to proceed with getting the financial data to be presented at another Committee Meeting.
- The **Energy update** was an overview of the Power Save Schools work and the School District's Energy Star ratings.
