**Telescope Basics**  
**A Perfect Time to Enjoy Your Telescope** - NEW

This course will be four consecutive weeks starting with the first class allowing students to calibrate their scopes so they can begin viewing right away. Then we will delve into the different types of eyepieces that are available and how they affect viewing through a telescope. The third class will focus on the types of telescopes and mounts that are available, as well as the pros and cons of each type. The final class will touch on basic astrophotography. During this class, we will start the course by locating the bright planets of Jupiter, Saturn and Mars. We will then spend time looking at the moon. Finally, the ultimate goal will be to use our telescopes to find the Andromeda Galaxy. ## Dog Obedience Training

Teach your dog to be a better companion through behavior-oriented exercises. Dogs will learn to sit, lie down, stay, stand, heel (walk by your side without pulling), come when called and remain in control when approached and touched by a stranger. Motivation is stressed, correction or punishment is de-emphasized. Minimum age of dog is eight weeks. Class size is limited to six dogs.

## Canine Good Citizen

CGC is a ten-skill training program that's open to all dogs—purebred and mixed breed—that focuses on teaching the basics of good manners and obedience, instilling the values of responsible ownership, and strengthening the bond between you and your dog at home and out in the community. This class is for those who want to obtain the AKC Canine Good Citizen title for their dogs. You will learn the skills needed to pass the test, but the testing date will be determined at a later date by the CGC organization. It is required to have all students present for the testing at Molly's Country Kennels on that date. The dog\handler have to show control with other people and dogs present. Pre-requisite: Level I Obedience Training (puppy kindergarten is not sufficient).
